ORDER ON MOTION TO ADMIT ADAM M. GOODMAN *PRO HAC VICE* FOR A PERIOD OF 60 DAYS IN ALL MATTERS BEFORE THE COURT IN WHICH THE CHAPTER 13 TRUSTEE APPEARS

The Assistant United States Trustee for the District of Wyoming has moved the Court to admit Adam M. Goodman, Chapter 13 Standing Trustee for the District of Wyoming, *pro hac vice* in all matters before the Court in which the Chapter 13 Standing Trustee appears for a period of 60 days. The reason for the motion is that the staff attorney for the Chapter 13 Standing Trustee has been appointed as Chapter 13 Standing Trustee for the Western District of Tennessee and Mr. Goodman's application for admission to the Wyoming Bar is pending.

The District Court Local Rules and Local Bankruptcy Rule 9010-1 do not contemplate an open-ended order admitting an attorney *pro hac vice* in all cases. Here, however, the motion covers a specific period of time, and under the circumstances, the request is appropriate. It is, therefore, ORDERED that:

 Mr. Goodman is admitted *pro hac vice* in all matters pending before the Court for a period of 60 days, effective May 11, 2023; and 2. The United States Trustee is excused from local counsel responsibilities for Mr. Goodman for

a period of 60 days, effective May 11, 2023.
