ORDER ON CENTRALIZED SERVICES

Due to limitations of staffing and resources available to the District of Wyoming, as well as the availability of 24/7 electronic filing for the past ten years, the court finds it necessary to centralize the services available to the public and bar.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED:

1. Effective October 1, 2012 the divisional office, located in Casper, Wyoming will no longer be staffed.
2. Evidentiary hearings will be scheduled in Cheyenne, Wyoming. Parties requesting video participation from other locations must comply with the Wyoming Local Bankruptcy Rules. Parties may request to attend by video from the Ewing T. Kerr Federal Courthouse, and if available, the court may enter an order providing for its use.
