ORDER ESTABLISHING THE PROCEDURE FOR THE ENTRY OF AN INDIVIDUAL
DEBTOR'S DISCHARGE IN A CHAPTER 11

The court finds it necessary to implement a procedure for the entry of a discharge for an individual Chapter 11 debtor as the discharge may not be entered until such time as plan payments are completed, which may be after the case is closed.


THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) In a chapter 11 case, filed by an individual who is eligible for a discharge under 11 U.S.C. § 1141(d)(5) and the case has been closed, the debtor shall file a notice of completion of plan payments containing a verified certification of compliance and a motion for the entry of debtor's discharge. Debtor shall serve the motion and notice of opportunity to object, including an objection deadline, to all parties on the debtor's matrix.
- (2) Upon a debtor filing the above notice and motion, the case will be reopened under 11 U.S.C. §350 without the payment of a filing fee.
- (3) If no objections are filed, the court shall enter the debtor's discharge and re-close the case. If objections are filed, the court shall set the matter for hearing.
