**UNITED STATES TRUSTEE'S STANDING MOTION TO

1. The failure to timely file lists, schedules, statements and other required documents to commence a case as required by the Bankruptcy Code, Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, and Local Bankruptcy Rules that unreasonably delays the efficient administration of cases and is prejudicial to the trustee, creditors and other parties in interest.

2. A deficient case as defined in L.B.R. 1017-2(A), is cause for dismissal pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 707(a), 1112(b) and (e), 1208(c) and 1307(c).

3. The deficiencies in the filings in this case constitute cause for dismissal pursuant to L.B.R.1017-2.

Wherefore, the UST respectfully requests that the Court dismiss, after notice as provided for in L.B.R. 1017-2, any case in which there is a deficient case filing as defined in L.B.R. 1017-2, and for such other and further relief as the Court deems appropriate.
