General Order 18-01

ORDER EXTENDING DEADLINES APPLICABLE TO UNITED STATES GOVERNMENTAL UNITS DURING SHUT DOWN

This matter is before the court *sua sponte*. The court finds that in the event of a "shut down" of the United States government, many federal governmental units may be temporarily unable to meet pending deadlines in bankruptcy cases, contested matters and adversary proceedings pending before the court.

IT IS ORDERED that to the extent authorized under the Bankruptcy Code; the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; and Wyoming Local Bankruptcy Rules:

- (1) All deadlines imposed by the Code, Rules and Local Rules or by court order that apply to a United States governmental unit, including but not limited to: the office of the United States Trustee and the United States Attorney District of Wyoming are extended by the same number of days the United States government is shut down, unless the court orders otherwise upon a finding of compelling circumstances;
- (2) Trials and hearings scheduled during this period involving a governmental unit, will be continued on a case-by-case basis by order of the court, which may be entered *sua sponte*, with notice to the parties. The court will reschedule the trials and hearings at dates to be determined; and
 - (3) General Order 18-01 is effective immediately.
