**ORDER TERMINATING GENERAL ORDER 13-02 AND SPECIFYING THE
NUMBER OF DAYS DEADLINES ARE EXTENDED**

The court finds that the United States governmental shut-down ended. It is necessary to terminate the Order Extending Deadlines Applicable to United States Governmental Units During Government Shut Down and specify the number of days deadlines are extended, pursuant to General Order 13-02.

IT IS ORDERED that,

- (1) Deadlines imposed by the Code, the Rules, the Local Rules or by an order of this court that apply to a United States governmental unit, including but not limited to, the Office of the United States Trustee and the United States Attorney - District of Wyoming are extended by 17 days.
- (2) Fed.R.Bank.P. 9006(f) applies with respect to computation of extended deadlines under this General Order;
- (3) Trials and hearings will be rescheduled by separate orders.
