ORDER ESTABLISHING THE PROCEDURE FOR THE ENTRY OF AN INDIVIDUAL DEBTOR'S DISCHARGE IN A CHAPTER 11

The court finds it necessary to implement a procedure for the entry of a discharge for an <u>individual Chapter 11 debtor</u> as the discharge may not be entered until such time as plan payments are completed, which may be after the case is closed.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) In a chapter 11 case, filed by an individual who is eligible for a discharge under 11 U.S.C. § 1141(d)(5) and the case has been closed, the debtor shall file a notice of completion of plan payments containing a verified certification of compliance and a motion for the entry of debtor's discharge. Debtor shall serve the motion and notice of opportunity to object, including an objection deadline, to all parties on the debtor's matrix.
- (2) Upon a debtor filing the above notice and motion, the case will be a reopened under 11 U.S.C. §350 without the payment of a filing fee.
- (3) If no objections are filed, the court shall enter the debtor's discharge and re-close the case. If objections are filed, the court shall set the matter for hearing.
